Development control has little impact on the natural environment except by preventing 'pollution' in its widest sense - air and water, the visual impact of structures, excessive noise, unnecessary lighting, unfriendly design etc. The aspects of the Park which should be given particular priority are: long views to unbroken skylines; the absence of light and noise; very clean streams. The most damaging structures are electricity and telephone wires and supports; radio masts, large standardised farm buildings, all of which seem to be 'necessary evil', though under grounding of wires in villages would be the biggest single improvement to the Park's environment, and should be attainable.
