



North York Moors National Park

Moorland walk (Key stage 2)

Standard route 2.5 km or extended route 4.5 km

A circular walk from The Moors National Park Centre with spectacular views of the Esk Valley. Children are divided into small groups and each group is provided with a map and a bag containing mystery objects relating to numbered points on the map. Children take it in turns to lead and use their mystery objects as prompts to tell the rest of the class something about the landscape and how it is used.



Age Range: Years 3 to 6 (Age 7 to 11)

Duration: Standard route 1½ to 2 hours / Extended route: up to 3 hours

Location: Danby Lodge National Park Centre

Key learning objectives

Children should learn...

Geography

- to follow a route use a map
- to recognise features on a map and in the landscape

- how people use the landscape

Science

- about plants and animals that live in a moorland habitat

Other skills involved

- team working
- looking carefully / observation skills
- asking questions
- speaking to a group

Learning outcomes

All children will be able to:

- recognise some map symbols and follow a route on a map
- identify a way in which the landscape is being used by people

Most children will be able to:

- match features on a map to the landscape
- identify several different types of land use in a landscape
- explain the water cycle using geographical vocabulary
- explain how moorland is managed for red grouse and formulate their own opinion about it

Some children will be able to:

- explain why the landscape is being used like it is
- explain arguments for and against grouse shooting.

Assessment for learning

We assess learning using a variety of techniques appropriate to the activity such as: questioning, questioning games, observing how well children are performing tasks, checking results, quizzes and feedback forms.

Ideas for extending learning before and after this activity

Find the North York Moors on a map of Britain. Can children also find Danby and Danby Lodge National Park Centre?
