




The Lost Words Adventure

A lovely day exploring the wildlife highlighted in the bestselling book 'The Lost Words'. Children hunt for the lost words in Crow Wood and make a collective acrostic poem. We then take you on a gorgeous 1km story walk through woods, fields and down to a small stream. Through the story we discover some of the 'lost' creatures and take part in minibeast hunts and games, whilst making weasel homes and natural artwork.

Age Range: Years 1 and 2 (Age 5 to 7)
Duration: Full day 10:00am – 2:30pm (flexible)
Location: The Moors National Park Centre

Main Curriculum Links:

Literacy - Develop pleasure in reading by listening to a wide range of stories.
Participate in discussion about what is read to them
Science – plants, animals, living things and their habitats



Key Learning Objectives Children should learn...	Learning Outcomes
