



## North York Moors National Park Education Service Activities for Uniformed Groups



### Cubs: Hikes Away Staged Activity Badge

This visit comprises one hike for the staged activity badge.

Cubs must do a hike or journey which involves at least three hours of activity and has a purpose. The sorts of activity that count as a hike away include:

- walking up a hill and enjoying the view

At the end of the session each child is presented with a certificate of merit.



#### Choose from one of the following walks:

##### Moorland Walk (outdoor session)

A circular walk from The Moors National Park Centre (5 km), with spectacular views of the Esk Valley, and returning through nearby farmland. Cubs take it in turns to lead the walk and get involved in games and activities along the way.

##### Levisham Moor Walk (outdoor session)

A spectacular, circular walk of 6 km in the heart of the North York Moors. Cubs take it in turns to lead the walk and learn about the amazing landscape features of the Hole of Horcum and Newtondale Gorge, evidence of Bronze Age and Iron Age occupation, the North Yorkshire Moors Railway and how moorland is managed. **NB.** Please note that there are no toilets or wet weather shelter available during this walk.
