¹Additional stone requirement: If additional stone is needed to complete walling work, the source of the stone must be agreed with the Authority in writing before work starts. If it is agreed that derelict walls can be used as a source of stone, the foundation stones must be left in situ as a record of the historic feature.

²Walling measurements: Please calculate the restoration area in m², *ignoring any sections of the boundary which will not need work*. If you are applying for more than one boundary, please add all restoration sections together to give a total measurement across all boundaries, and clearly mark the map.

³Hedge planting: Hedges need to be planted at 6 plants per metre length, with 1 guard and 1 cane per plant – see Hedgerow Planting specifications for further details (N.B. guards and canes are not required where rabbit netting supplement is used instead).

⁴Fencing: Please ensure the whole boundary is fenced against stock, even if boundary work is only gapping up. If no fencing is needed, please explain why in The Work description box e.g. 'Existing fence will be stockproof for at least five years.'
